

Standards of Judgement and the Laws of the Universe

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I mentioned before that the proper standards for judgement can be found in nature. The order of the universe is love, and this gives life to all living things. This is a universe where all things are animated for a certain time and eventually come to an end, where new beginnings arise from the ending of others. The anti-thesis of receiving life and giving life is that we deal death to others and in turn are dealt our death. This can be interpreted as love from the fact that this exchange is necessary for others to live.

The True Law is the order of the universe. We do not ask that you understand this. What is important is how you put this teaching to use for yourself. The law of nature as a standard of judgement is a rather primitive standard as far as standards go. The reason is that, although man lives in nature, he is an animal which has become one step removed from nature. Man has emotions like hate, joy and sadness which make it possible for him to recognize love. If the laws of nature were to be applied directly in human society, the existence of weak people would not be permitted, and the world would be devoid of compassion.

Compassion gives mankind who is full of error a chance to regain his uprightness. It is an emotion which comes to the rescue of beings who are about to experience some form of pain. There is nothing so great about learning and becoming aware of the laws of nature. The real problem is how to apply the laws of nature for good ends. One must find out what is the truth for man which exists in nature, and how he must live and which direction he should take. Man is unable to live all by himself. Thus, you must re-examine the order of the universe from the standpoint of what laws should be respected within society.
