

The True Teaching of Heaven and the False Teaching

Nevertheless, do not, like the organizer of meetings in Osaka who rashly announced the dissolution of her group because she said there were no teachings, and casually draw the conclusion that Heaven no longer exists just because you do not agree with everything that is said in these messages. The discourse on the True Law this month is just as enlightening as in previous months, so read this first and then study the law. The speakers and organizers who write articles for this magazine, because of their scholarship and depth of insight have especially been granted the permission by us to freely expound on the True Law.

As all of you are aware, December is the month in which Christ who has been accepted widely in the world as the savior of mankind was born. It is a month of miracles for Christians as well as those of us in Heaven. Mankind must once more meditate on the teachings of God which Jesus preached during his brief sojourn on earth, and renew their understanding about the significance and role of light and darkness, angels and devils, together with the Last Judgement and God's salvation of mankind.

The dominance of evil spirits has become especially marked today, and they are extending their evil grip over various regions of Japan to recapture the leadership of the GLA after its dissolution. "One should not conclude therefore that true miracles do not exist just because there are so many false miracles. Instead, one should realize that real miracles exist just because there are false miracles. One has to conclude that only because there are true ones, there are also false ones."

"If signs attributable to the side of the devil and demons occur for the disbeliever, a strong sign most certainly should be manifested on the side of God."

The disciple of Jesus Christ, Paul, has also stated as follows:

“The coming of the lawless one by the activity of Satan will be with all power and with pretended signs and wonders, and with all wicked deception for those who are to perish, because they refused to love the truth and so be saved. Therefore, God sends upon them a strong delusion to make them believe what is false, so that all may be condemned who did not believe the truth but had pleasure in unrighteousness.”
